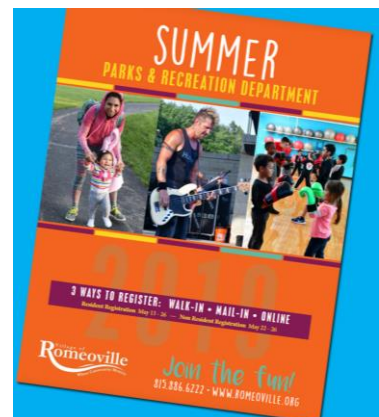

**Romeoville Recreation Offers Programs from Unicorn Parties to Nerf Wars**

*Resident Registration Begins May 13th*

Summer will be here before you know it and that means program registration is coming up. Every resident in Romeoville should have received a program brochure in the mail with the various program offerings. The 60+ page brochure is divided into 25 categories like Day Camps, Karate, Gymnastics, Youth Athletics, Young Adults, Adults & Trips, and Fitness.

Some activities that are sure to be big draws are the Parents vs. Teen Nerf League (pg. 57 in the program brochure), where whole families can engage in all out Nerf war, and the LEGO Engineering & LEGO Robotics Academy (pg. 40), where kids will explore STEM topics through LEGOs. - **Mail in:** Print out a registration form online or pick one up at the Rec Center and mail it to 900 W. Romeo Road, Romeoville, IL 60446.
