Ever think of becoming a firefighter? Well here's your chance!! Our Basic Operations Firefighter (B.O.F.) (formerly Firefighter II) Academy will train the entry level recruit in the basics of firefighting from A – Z. B.O.F. is required by the majority of Illinois fire departments as a condition of hire. This program will cover all the cognitive objectives in all three modules of the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) B.O.F. curriculum, as well as performing and testing on all practical hands-on skills, including extensive live-fire evolutions. Students will receive repetitive practice, review, and testing on all aspects of the program. Students will also be expected to participate in daily physical training to ensure peak performance. By graduation students will have completed all classroom lessons and required practical evolutions. The program will also include Hazardous Materials Operations, Technical Rescue Awareness, CPR certification, Fire Service Vehicle Operator, the Courage to be Safe course, and NIMS IC 100 & 700. Students may attend the program even if not affiliated with a fire department. Please see the Frequently Asked Questions notice on our website regarding this. Note: completion of this course does not provide employment with the Romeoville Fire Dept. Programs are approved by the Illinois State Approving Agency for the enrollment of qualified veterans and/or other eligible persons to receive Montgomery GI Bill education benefits.
