Ever think of becoming a paramedic, firefighter, or emergency healthcare professional? Well here's your chance!! Our EMT-B course is fully compliant with the standards set forth by the Illinois Department of Public Health. Upon completion of the course and the state exam, students will be licensed as an Illinois EMT-B.

Course curriculum includes medical & legal, moving patients, patient assessment, communications & documentation, pharmacology, respiratory emergencies, trauma, ambulance operations, Healthcare Provider CPR certification, and much more. All of these topics will be reinforced by extensive hands-on skills that will give the students the confidence to perform as a pre-hospital care-giver. Students will also be required to complete clinical time in a hospital emergency department and ambulance ride time with the Romeoville Fire Dept.

An advantage to our course is that students do not have to pay a per credit hour fee as with most community colleges making our course a financially sensible choice. All required textbooks are included in the course tuition. Note: completion of this course does not provide a job with the Romeoville Fire Dept.
