Ever think of becoming a firefighter? Well here's your chance!! Our Basic Operations Firefighter (Firefighter II) Academy will train the entry level recruit in the basics of firefighting from A – Z. Upon completion of the Academy and passage of the state exam, recruits will become a state certified Firefighter II, which is required by the majority of Illinois fire departments as a condition of hire. This program will cover all the cognitive objectives in all three modules of the Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) Firefighter curriculum, as well as performing and testing on all practical hands-on skills, including extensive live-fire evolutions. Students will receive repetitive practice, review, and testing on all aspects of the program. Students will also be expected to participate in daily physical training to ensure peak performance. By graduation students will have completed all classroom lessons and required practical evolutions. The program will also include Hazardous Materials Awareness, Technical Rescue Awareness, CPR certification, and NIMS IC 100 & 700. Basic Operations Firefighter will be offered once the new curriculum is released by the OSFM, which should be very early 2010. Until then the current Firefighter II curriculum will be offered. Students needing P.P.E. and / or SCBA, there will be a \$ 200.00 equipment surcharge. Note: completion of this course does not provide a job with the Romeoville Fire Dept.
