## **TAX LEVY ORDINANCE FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL 30, 2024**

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVYING AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING THE FIRST DAY OF MAY, 2023 AND ENDING THE 30TH DAY OF APRIL 2024.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**Section 1:** That a tax for the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, is hereby assessed and levied upon and against all real and personal property within the corporate limits of the Village of Romeoville, Will County, Illinois, subject to taxation according to the value of said property as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes for the current fiscal year which said tax is hereby levied for the current fiscal year of said Village commencing on the first day of May, 2023 and ending the 30th day of April, 2024 and said levy and collection of taxes to be applied for liquidation and payment of the appropriations heretofore made by the Appropriation Ordinance heretofore passed and published by and under the authority of the Village of Romeoville, Will County, Illinois.

**Section 2:** That the amounts hereinafter set forth or so much thereof as may be authorized by law as may be needed are to be used for the purposes as are hereinafter described and enumerated.

That the amounts appropriated for each object or purpose appear in the column under the words "APPROPRIATED". The amounts appropriated are totaled for each subdivision as a total of that column. The amount to be raised by taxation is totaled for each subdivision as total of that column under the words "LEVIED".

**Section 3:** That any unexpected balance of any item of appropriation made by this Ordinance may be expended in making up any insufficiency in any other item of appropriation made by this Ordinance.

**Section 4:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

**Section 5:** That this Ordinance be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recording, and publication as provided by law.


That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Will County, Illinois, a certified copy of this Ordinance in conformity with the



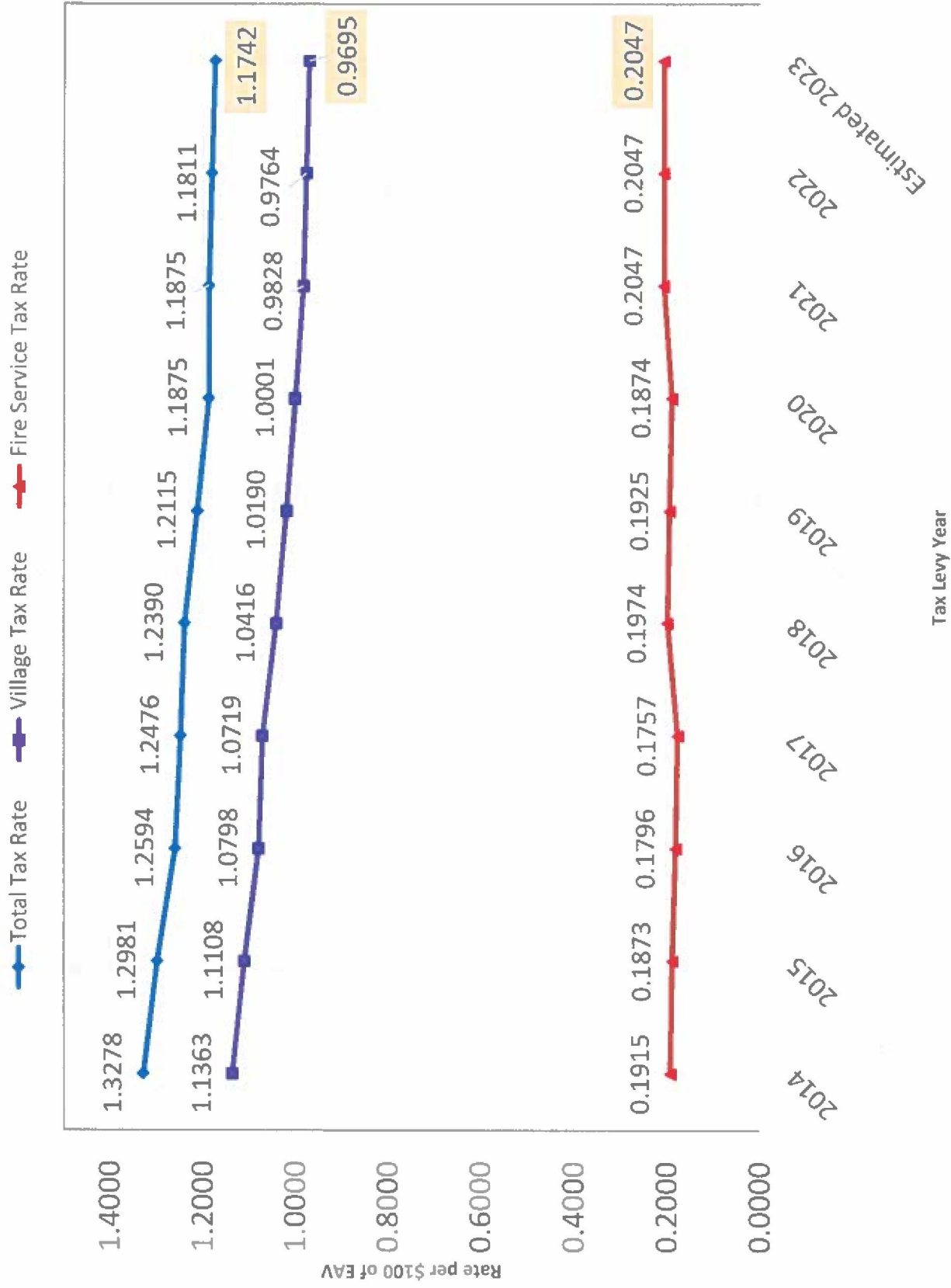



## **An Ordinance Establishing Maximum Tax Rates for The Village of Romeoville and Authorizing the Village Manager and Finance Director to Make the Appropriate Adjustments and Abatements to the 2023 Tax Levy for the Village of Romeoville, Will County, Illinois**

WHEREAS, the Village of Romeoville has a population of more than 25,000 persons and is, therefore, a home rule unit under subsection (a) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, moral and welfare; and

WHEREAS, December 6, 2023 the Village of Romeoville adopted Ordinance No. 23-1873 which established the tax levy for the Village of Romeoville; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the Village President and Village Board that the Village of Romeoville tax levy will generate a maximum tax rate not to exceed 1.030 per one hundred dollars of equalized assessed value; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the Village President and Village Board that the Village of Romeoville Fire tax levy will generate a maximum tax rate not to exceed .2200 per one hundred dollars of equalized assessed value; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Village Board hereby authorize the County Clerk of Will County, at the direction of the Village Manager and Finance Director, to make the appropriate adjustments and abatements in the 2023 tax levy for the Village of Romeoville.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**Section 1:** The Village President and Village Board hereby determine and declare that the Village of Romeoville Maximum Tax Rate not to exceed 1.0300 per one hundred dollars of equalized assessed value.

**Section 2:** The Village President and Village Board hereby determine and declare that the Village of Romeoville Fire Maximum Tax Rate not to exceed .2200 per one hundred dollars of equalized assessed value.

**Section 3:** If the Village Manager reasonably determines that the tax rate to be extended for the 2023

levy year will exceed the Village of Romeoville Maximum Tax Rate, the Village Manager is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order to the Will County Clerk abating the Village of Romeoville Tax Levy in an amount necessary to adjust and abate the extended Village of Romeoville Tax Rate to produce a rate equal to or below the Village of Romeoville Maximum Tax Rate of 1.0300 per one hundred dollars of equalized assessed value. The Village Manager may direct the Finance Director to make the rate determination and to issue the abatement order authorized by this Ordinance.

**Section 4:** If the Village Manager reasonably determines that the tax rate to be extended for the 2023 levy year will exceed the Village of Romeoville Fire Maximum Tax Rate, the Village Manager is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order to the Will County Clerk abating the Village of Romeoville Fire Tax Levy in an amount necessary to adjust and abate the extended Village of Romeoville Fire Tax Rate to produce a rate equal to or below the Village of Romeoville Fire Maximum Tax Rate of .2200 per one hundred dollars of equalized assessed value. The Village Manager may direct the Finance Director to make the rate determination and to issue the abatement order authorized by this Ordinance.

**Section 5:** That this Ordinance be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recording, and publication as provided by law.





## **An Ordinance Abating the Tax Heretofore Levied for the Year 2023 to Pay Principal and Interest On \$12,870,000 Taxable General Obligation Bonds 2013 Series A, of the Village of Romeoville, Will County, Illinois**

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Romeoville, Will County, Illinois, by ordinance adopted on the 2nd day of July, 2013, (the "Ordinance") did provide for the issuance of \$12,870,000 TAXABLE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS 2013 SERIES A, (the "Bonds") and the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay the principal of and the interest on the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Village will have cash available and set aside to provide for the payment of principal and interest on the Bonds up to and including January 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the Village that the tax heretofore levied for the year 2023 to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds to be abated:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

### **SECTION I: ABATEMENT OF TAX**

The tax heretofore levied for the year 2023 in the Ordinance is hereby abated in its entirety.

### **SECTION II: FILING OF ORDINANCE**

Forthwith upon the adoption of this Ordinance, the Village Clerk shall file a certified copy hereof with the County Clerk of Will County, Illinois, and it shall be the duty of said County Clerk to abate said tax levied for the year 2023 in accordance with the provisions hereof.

### **SECTION III: EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

### **SECTION IV:**

All ordinances, resolutions, or motions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Romeoville, Will County, Illinois, by ordinance adopted on the 21st day of August, 2019 (the "Ordinance") did provide for the issuance of \$20,250,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS 2019 SERIES B, (the "Bonds") and the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay the principal of and the interest on the Bonds; and
