ACCOUNT CREATION AND APPROVAL PROCESS

Create Account at: www.romeoville.org/recreation

RESIDENT:

Your account must be verified and approved in order to receive resident rates. **No refunds will be given if you register at non-residential rates.**

To verify your residency:

- Once account is created; email household residency documents to recinfo@romeoville.org in order to establish your household as a resident of Romeoville.
- We will need two of the following items to establish residency:
 - State-Issued ID card (current) and
 - One of the following items:
 - ComEd, Nicor, or Water Bill (current)
 - Property Tax Bill (current)
 - Vehicle Registration (current)
 - Mortgage or Rental Agreement
- Please wait 24 hours for residency approval after creating account. You will receive a confirmation email from recinfo@romeoville.org and can proceed with registration.
- Every two years residents are required to renew their proof of residency.**

Once your account is created you can proceed with registration.

RESIDENCY INFORMATION

Residents may register all days of registration by mail, walk-in, or online (some programs are not eligible for online registration). In district fees are for Romeoville residents. Please be prepared to show identification during all registration periods to ensure residency and confirm information on file.

NON-RESIDENCY INFORMATION

Mail-in, walk-in and online registration from non-residents will only be accepted during the non-resident registration period. Non-resident fees are 1.5 times more for programs unless otherwise noted.

Please note: Romeoville residents have priority in registering for all programs. Some programs are not available for online registration.

PROGRAM & CLASS CANCELLATIONS

If the program is canceled due to insufficient registration, a full refund will be made through the Village within fifteen (15) to thirty (30) working days. If a class is canceled during the program, participants will be notified of the make up date by phone, a hand-out at class, or via e-mail.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds are issued as follows - 100% before the start of week one; 75% before the start of week two; 50% before the start of week three; 25% before the start of week four; and NO REFUND after week four. Cash or check transactions will be refunded by check through the Village of Romeoville within four (4) to six (6) weeks. Credit card transactions will be refunded back to the ORIGINAL credit card within 14 days of refund approval. In the event that the original credit card is no longer valid (expired/lost/stolen) the refund will be processed by check within four (4) to six (6) weeks. Recreation account credits will be applied within seven (7) days after approval.

Refund amount is subject to change for one day programs and/or various classes/camps/trips.

INSURANCE

The Romeoville Recreation Department carries no medical insurance and assumes no liability for personal injuries or loss of personal property while attending Recreation Department activities. A participant's own policy must cover any medical costs incurred.

INCLUSION AIDES

Northern Will County Special Recreation Association provides qualified staff to help assist the Romeoville Recreation Department's community recreation leaders in providing recreational programs for children and adults with special needs in a safe environment. Inclusion aides assist participants with recreation activities and with any accommodations needed to make sure it is an optimal experience for participants. If your child needs assistance, please mention this on your registration form or upon registration. We do our best to provide inclusion aides for all requests; however, from time to time an aide may not be available because of the class time or day and/or staff availability.

LOST CARD FEE

A \$5.00 fee will be charged for any replacement membership card or punch pass card. This includes Fit 4 Life, Aquatic Center, Open Gym, and all reloadable punch passes.

RESIDENT RATE

A Resident Rate Status is available for non residents who wish to register for classes at a resident rate. This can be purchased for \$150 per household and will allow non residents to register for classes at the resident rate during the non-resident registration period (walk-in registration only). A Resident Rate Status is good for one year from the date of issue. These passes are eligible for all recreation classes; they do not apply to the Birthday Party Packages, Open Gym, Open Swim, Child Care, Jungle Safari Indoor Playground, Fit 4 Life Memberships, Aquatic Center Memberships, or rentals. (New fee effective 5/1/23)

PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIPS

Program scholarships are to assist families in need and are based on the availability of funds. These scholarships are only available to Romeoville residents who can provide proof of income or eligibility of need (i.e. free/reduced school lunch program, IL Dept. Of Public Aid recipient, most recent W-2 for all members living in household). In addition, proof of Romeoville residency is also required. Applications can be picked up at the Recreation Center and must be submitted during the registration period with supporting documentation. Notification of scholarship approval will be provided after the registration period. Scholarships will not provide 100% of program fees and do not pay for program supplies. Day Camp, Preschool, and Before and After School childcare programs are excluded. Please contact the Recreation Center for more information at 815-886-6222

Pool HOURS

OPEN SWIM

Open Swim features the interactive play area with zero-depth entry, aquatic basketball and volleyball court area, lazy river, vortex pool, and the 20-foot-tall, 150-foot-long water slide. This is the ideal time to visit the Aquatic Center with family and friends for a fun-filled day.

TOT SWIM

Our interactive play area with zero-depth entry is available during Tot Swim. This time is designated for young swimmers (age 5 and under) to enjoy the water with an adult. Other areas of the facility may not be available at this time.

SENSORY SWIM

Sensory Swim is designed specifically for individuals with special needs, offering a calm and quiet pool environment. During these sessions, there is no loud music or overwhelming noise, providing a soothing space for relaxation and fun. A quiet room will also be available for those who need a peaceful retreat from the pool environment.

LAP SWIM

Our three 20-yard lap lanes are open for use by members and guests during Lap Swim. At busier times, swimmers may be asked to share lanes; we can help you find the lane that suits your speed! Other areas of the facility may not be available at this time.

RIVER WALKING

As part of our Aquatic Fitness offerings, River Walking is scheduled time for members and guests to utilize the current of the lazy river for their personal fitness routine. Other areas of the facility may not be available at this time.

Children up to 12 months will be admitted for free.

Children 12 years or younger must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.

Swim Pants

- All swimmers age 2 and under (or regularly diapered) must wear a facility approved swim pant.
- Swim pants must be plastic lined with elastic around the legs/waist.
- Disposable swim diapers are not approved.
- Swim pants are available for purchase at the Aquatic Center for \$10.

Flotation Devices

- All flotation devices must be US Coast Guard approved.
- Complimentary life jackets in a variety of sizes are available on a first come first served basis.
- Children wearing life jackets must be within arm's reach of a parent or guardian in the water at all times.
- No inflatable devices such as water wings, infant rafts, or inner tubes are allowed.

Add a splash of creativity to your evening at the Aquatic Center!

Creative Current is a relaxed, self-guided art and craft experience designed to bring families to the pool on quieter nights. Each session features a fun, themed craft with all materials provided, plus a sample project to inspire your own creation. This is a drop-in, self-paced activity—not a formal class. Our staff will be present to supervise and offer help as needed, but participants are encouraged to create at their own pace and enjoy quality time together.

Admission & Participation Info:

Each child registration includes open swim admission and one craft kit to complete during the session.

Each adult registration includes open swim admission only (no craft kit).

All children must have a registered adult attending with them.

Bonus Splash Time:

After the craft, participants are invited to stay and enjoy open swim for the rest of the evening—admission is included!

Please note: any additional swimmers, including parents, siblings, or friends, will need to pay the regular daily admission.

Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult in the pool area.

WATER BABIES

Waterbabies introduces you and your child to basic aquatic skills. An adult is required to accompany each child in the water and participate in every class. The adult participants learn too! As parents, you learn how to safely work with your child in the water, including how to appropriately support and hold your child in the water and how to prepare and encourage your child to participate fully and try skills. In addition, you are introduced to several water safety topics. Your child receives an introduction to basic skills that lay the foundation for learning to swim.

PRESCHOOL AQUATIC SWIM LESSONS

AGE: 3-5 FEE: \$80R / \$120NR

Preschool Aquatics put the "fun" in fundamentals. Each of the three levels is loaded with enjoyable, engaging, and challenging activities that motivate children to want to perform and learn to swim. In Level 1, your child will be introduced to basic skills that lay the foundation for developing water competency and the future skill development of swimming strokes. Your child will start to develop positive attitudes and safe practices around the water. Preschool Level 2 marks the beginning of independent aquatic locomotion skills. Children continue to explore using simultaneous and alternating arm actions on the front and back to gain greater proficiency in preparation for performing strokes. Participants in Level 3 are taking their previously learned techniques to a whole new level. These swimmers will learn how to perform all their skills independently.

To determine the appropriate level for your child, use the guidelines below. Your child should be able to CONSISTENTLY demonstrate the skills mentioned and be COMFORTABLE doing so. If you do not check ALL the boxes under a level, please register your child for that level. If you checked ALL the boxes, please continue to the next level. Swimmer may be moved to a different level as deemed necessary by the swim instructor staff.

Level 1

Skills can be performed with support

- Swimmer can willingly enter the water independently using a ramp, steps, or side and walk at least 5 yards where they can touch.
- Swimmer can submerge their mouth and nose and blow bubbles for at least 3 seconds.
- Swimmer can exit the water safely.
- Swimmer can comfortably glide on their front with support.
- Swimmer can comfortably float on their back with support.

Skills can be performed with some assistance

- Swimmer can glide on their front for at least 2 body lengths.
- Swimmer can roll onto their back and float for at least 15 seconds and stand up.
- Swimmer can glide on their back for at least 2 body lengths.
- Swimmer can roll to their front and stand up.



RIDER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Riders must call the Recreation Center to set up an account in Rec Trac and get registered in our system for Ride Around Town.
- **Riders must be able to travel to and from their door to the vehicle on their own and board the vehicle on their own. Drivers cannot physically assist riders.**
- **Wheelchair users must be able to get on and off the lift/ramp without assistance from the driver and must board facing away from the bus. Drivers will lock down the chair only.**
- Riders must handle their own personal bags and belongings during pick-up and drop-off. Riders can carry on/off no more than six bags.
- For safety reasons, driver has the right to refuse to a rider who is visibly sick.
- Payment for rides are made by our new reloadable punch pass in \$20 increments. Each punch equals \$1.
- Payment options for purchasing or reloading a punch pass:
 - Credit card over the phone by calling the Recreation Department 815-886-6222.
 - Cash/check given to the driver.
 - In person at the Recreation Center during open hours.
- Appointment availability will be limited due to additional time needed to clean the vehicle in between riders.
- Appointments must be made 48 hours in advance by calling the Recreation Department 815-886-6222. Voicemail messages will not be accepted for appointments. Please call for ride booking timeline.
- Riders must be ready within 15 minutes of pickup time or pickup will need to be rescheduled.
- Rides can only be made for essential trips i.e.; medical (routine), grocery store, employment, hair. Rides cannot be booked for doctor/hospital visits for a rider who is sick. The Recreation Department reserves the right to deny any appointment to and from a location that is not deemed essential.
- Seat belt must be worn at all times.
- The following is not allowed on the vehicles: eating, drinking, standing while vehicle is moving, or abusive language.
- Please do not leave any garbage on the bus, riders must take garbage with them.
- Riders are expected to be courteous to others.
- Riders 17 years old and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, 18 years and older.
- Riders must call within 24 hours to cancel an appointment or they will still be charged for the ride.

- All users must pay an annual fee, meet vaccination requirements, and sign a liability waiver to obtain a dog park membership.
- A membership must be purchased for each dog you bring to the park.
- Memberships are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- Proof of residency is required to receive resident rates.
- Residents who provide proof of Romeoville Animal License will receive a discounted rate. Romeoville Animal License must be obtained at Village Hall.
- You must provide up-to-date vaccination records when purchasing a membership.
- Each household receives one (1) access card regardless of the number of dogs owned, with a limit of 3 dogs per household based on village ordinance.


