4. Proofread your answers/essays in this application in addition to having at least one other person proofread your application. Spelling errors or poor writing skills will have a negative effect on your chances of receiving the scholarship.
5. Each application is judged on its own merit so include any information that makes you exceptional and a good candidate to receive the award.
6. Keep a copy of everything you submit!
7. Pay close attention to scholarship application deadlines as applications submitted past the deadline will not be considered.
8. Please include with this application a letter of recommendation from your ROTC instructor.
9. Commission reserves the right to withhold scholarship money if there are no qualified candidates.

THE RULES AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AWARDED AND THE PROGRAM ADMINISTERED SHALL BE:

1. Those eligible to apply for the scholarship shall be high school seniors who are Romeoville residents and currently serving in their high school ROTC program.
2. Proof of residency should be made available upon request.
3. Scholarship winners will have one (1) year to utilize their scholarship funds from the date of graduation from high school.
4. The Romeoville Veterans Commission ROTC Scholarship is for undergraduate study at an accredited U.S. college, university or trade school.
5. The scholarship funds may only be used to defray necessary costs of the student's education (i.e., tuition, room and board, books and supplies, fees and equipment required by the student's particular course of study or school).
6. Scholarship winner will receive a certificate naming the amount of the scholarship. Once the school is determined, the student must request their scholarship check. The scholarship check will be a two-party check made payable to the student and school.
7. Unused scholarship monies will be returned to the scholarship fund after one year.
8. Commission reserves the right to withhold scholarship money if there are no qualified candidates.
