Lake Michigan Allocation was submitted March 24, 2022


- **90 day initial review process**


Name

Secondary Water Delivery Point

All infrastructure (transmission mains, pump stations, etc.) shown between the Chicago Connection and each water delivery point would be owned by the Water Commission. All infrastructure (transmission mains, pump stations, etc.) including the piping leading to primary water delivery points would be included in the costs distributed to all Members of the Water Commission. Piping leading to secondary water delivery points (from the water commission transmission main) would be paid by the Member Community (but constructed and owned by the Water Commission).

Note: Location for facilities are conceptual and do not indicate final locations for the proposed infrastructure. Final siting and routing analyses are ongoing as part of the engineering design process.

Public Works/ Engineering Update

 - Facility use plan, backup wells identification

 - Long term watermain replacement plan




